

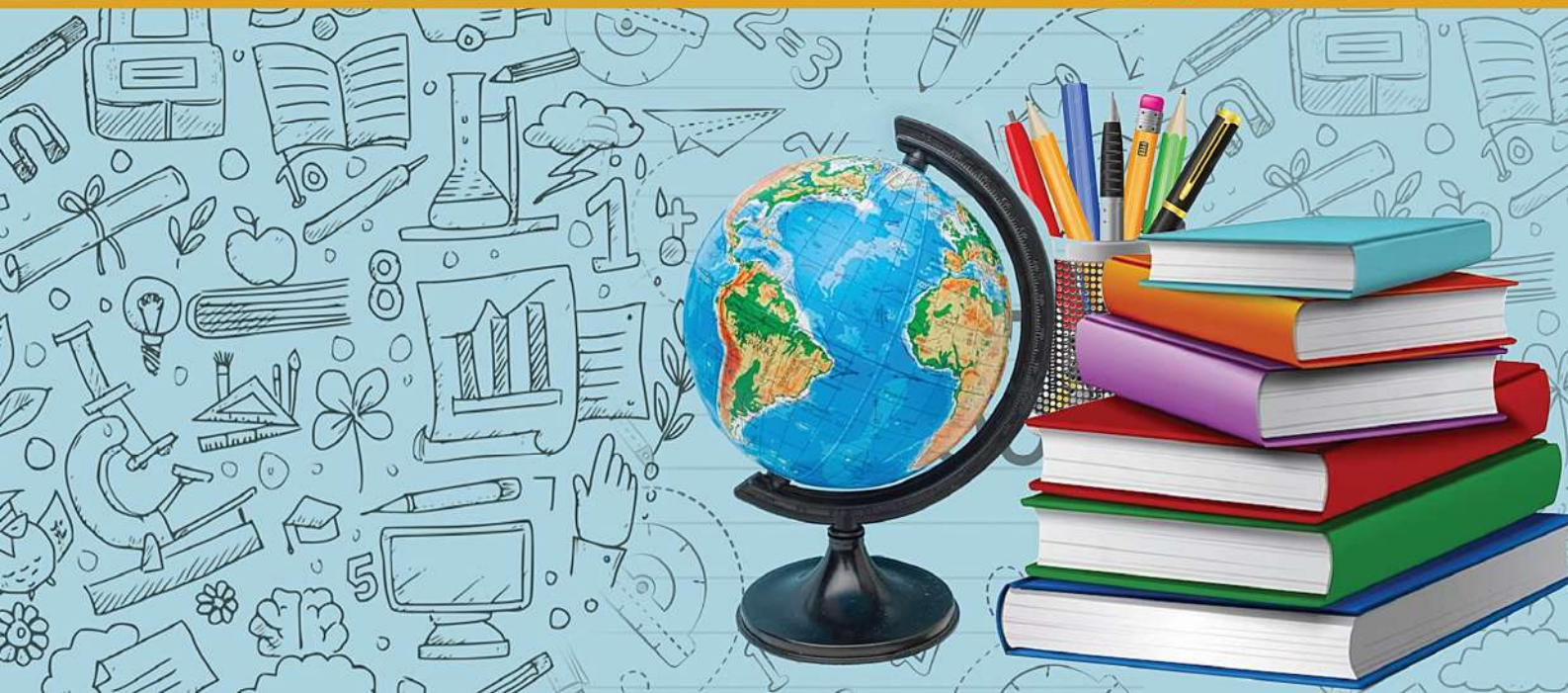

ASSEMBLY/ COLLECTIVE WORSHIP

ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING TO PARENTS

Regular assessments are made of each child's progress and these are used by teachers to plan the next building steps in learning. Formal termly assessments are also conducted in all subjects and the next steps in learning are shared with parents at termly parent/teacher conferences. In addition, parents receive a written Annual Report in the summer term which summarizes their child's overall progress and attainment. All the information regarding your ward will be furnished to parents at regular intervals.



SMART CARD



LIA provide smart card facility to the children through Smart Card, parents will get all the information about their child's progress and proximity in their phone itself through messaging system.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

School transport is available as an additional facility that may be availed of, on payment of transportation fee.

To avail school transportation, the Transport form has to be filled up and payment has to be made as stipulated.



RULES AND REGULATIONS
